

When do I need an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan?

An applicant must submit an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan to the Cecil Soil Conservation District for review and approval in any of the following instances:

1. A Grading Permit is required by the Cecil County Department of Land Use and Developmental Services and/or
2. 5,000 square feet or more of disturbance is proposed and/or
3. 100 cubic yards or more of earth movement is proposed
